

WHOSE AND POSSESSIVE 'S

POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVES ARE USED TO EXPRESS
POSSESSION AND OWNING.
AFTER POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVE, COMES A NOUN.

example: This is not **my** handbag.

Apart from Possessive Adjectives, We also use 's to define possession

For singular nouns, just add 's

Example: This is my friend's house.

*You can also use proper names (Jane's house).

**For plural
nouns
ending with
-s**

**Just add
apostrophe
(')**

Example:

Those are my friends' houses.

WHOSE

Whose is also a possessive pronoun. We use «whose» to learn which person something belongs to.

Example:

Whose pen is this?
Whose bag has been lost?

✓ **NOTE:** «WHOSE» AND «WHO'S» ARE NOT THE
SAME!

Who's = Who is

Example: Who's talking on the phone?
