## ON, IN, AT

Prepositions connects a noun, pronoun or noun phrase to other part of the sentence. On, in, and at are used to show place, direction, time or location.

There is almost no general rule about the prepositions, so you should learn the phrases that go with them.

# IN TO SHOW TIME

For months, years, seasons, centuries, ages  
we use «in».

in august

in 1999

in winter

in 19th century

in 1980's

in ice age

in the future or in the past

TO SHOW PLACE

For cities, countries, and enclosed places

in Istanbul

in Brazil

in the garden

in a car

in my bag

in Istiklal Street

in the box

# ON TO SHOW PLACE

Used to refer to the place on the surface of something, to describe floors, for public transports, or to say on media.

on the table
on the third floor
on a plane
on a bus
on the page
on the television
on the internet

# ON TO SHOW **TIME**

Used for the days of the months and special days.

on Monday
on Wednesday
on my birthday
on our wedding day
on the fifth anniversary
on 21st of April
on a sunny day

AT  
TO SHOW **PLACE**

Used to refer to a point, or top/bottom of something, institutions, cafes, restaurants, shops etc.

at the door

at the traffic light

at the top shelf

at the end of the street

at university

at home

at work

at the cafeteria

AT  
TO SHOW **TIME**

Used for hours of the day or parts of the day.

at 4 pm

at 12 am

at midnight

at noon

at new year's eve

at lunch time

at dinner

at the moment
