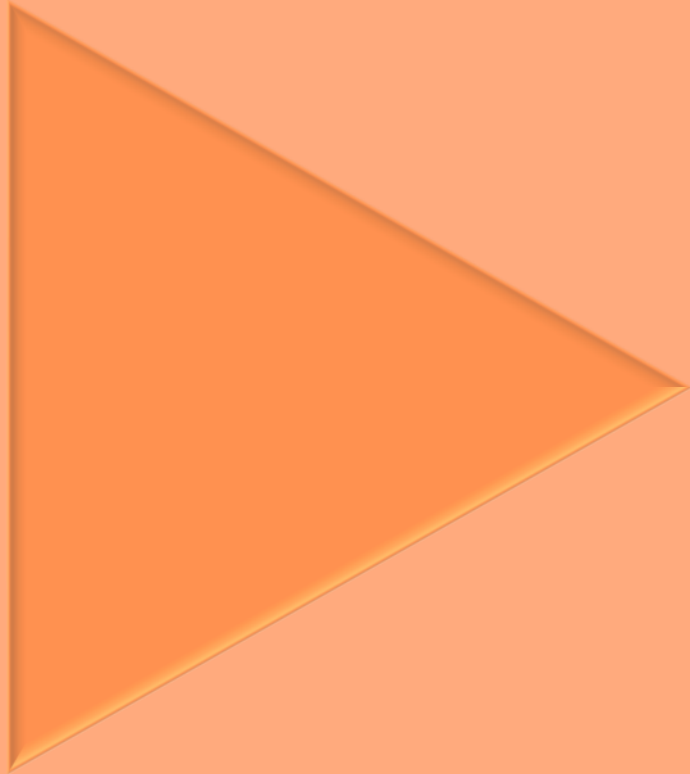

## Use of would like

- Use would like to talk about the actions you want to do. Use to infinitive(to V)
- I would like **to dance**.
- We would like **to go** out.
- She would like **to drink** coffee.
- Use would like with nouns. Not use to after would like.
- I would like **some tea**.
- She would like **an apple**.
- We would like **some water**, please.

- Would you like to dance?
- Would you like to drink something?
- Would you like to eat pizza?
- Would you like an apple?
- Would you like some water?
