


# ADJECTIVES

Adjectives gives us information about the features or quantity of a noun.

They describe the nouns in terms of features. For example; a big company, a green sweater, a fast animal etc.

They also describe the nouns in terms of quantity. For example; fourteen participants, some sugar, many people etc.

- Adjectives come before a noun.
  - There are different categories of adjectives in terms of what they describe.
  - Not that there is also an order of adjectives if a name carries more than one adjective.
  - The adjectives about views or attitudes comes before the factual ones. For example; «a beautiful red dress».
