

SUBJECT PRONOUNS VS OBJECT PRONOUNS

A pronoun is a word that takes the place of a noun. Subject pronouns are the nouns that are the actors of the main action.

EXAMPLE: It is spreading through sneezing and coughing.

Here « it » refers to the Coronavirus. But instead of the proper name, a subject pronoun is used.

Object pronouns are the pronouns that receive the action.

Subject Pronouns and Object Pronouns

| SUBJECT PRONOUNS | OBJECT PRONOUNS |
|-------------------------|------------------------|
| I | me |
| you | you |
| he, she, it | Him, Her, it |
| we | us |
| they | them |

Examples:

- ✓ I go running everyday. He also joins me.
- ✓ You are so kind. I like you.
- ✓ He is busy now. I don't want to disturb him.
- ✓ She got married. I will call and congratulate her.
- ✓ It is a very expensive dress. Are you going to buy it?
- ✓ We go to conversation club every Sunday. You can come with us.
- ✓ They are leaving tomorrow. You should go with them.
