

THE PASSIVE VOICE

in present simple and past simple


The passive voice is used to show interest in the object that experiences an action rather than the person or object that performs the action. In other words, the object of the sentence becomes the subject in passive voice.

Example:

Active: The firemen *put out* the fire yesterday.

Passive: The fire *was put out* by the firemen yesterday.

SIMPLE PRESENT	SIMPLE PAST
S (Obj.) + be (am/is/are) + V3	S (Obj.) + be (was/were) + V3
e.g.: The goods are shipped from this pier <i>every month</i> .	e.g.: The goods were shipped from this pier <i>last month</i> .



**Note that in passive voice,
we always use past
participle (V3) form of the verb,
no matter which tense we form
our sentences in.**

TIME REFERENCE	ACTIVE	PASSIVE
Simple Present	People speak <i>English</i> in Australia.	<i>English</i> is spoken (by people) in Australia.
Simple Present	Elton John plays <i>the most expensive piano in the world</i> .	<i>The most expensive piano in the world</i> is played by Elton John.
Simple Past	My grandpa paid <i>everyone's lunch</i> .	<i>Everyone's lunch</i> was paid by my grandpa.
Simple Past	We ainted <i>our house</i> yesterday.	<i>Our house</i> was painted (by us) yesterday.
