# ANOTHER- OTHER

**We use another and other as determiners**

another + singular noun

I want another bottle of water.

other + plural noun

I need to talk to other students.

# ANOTHER- OTHERS

**We use another as pronouns.  
Others is always a pronoun.**

I drank two cups of coffee, but I need another.

Ten students are in the class. Where are the others?

As pronouns  
they are not  
followed by a  
noun.

# OTHER- OTHERS

**We use others + plural noun as pronouns.  
Others is always a pronoun and not followed by a  
noun**

other + plural noun

Others  
Not followed by a noun

I will talk to other people before  
the decision.

Others approve the deal.

# THE OTHER- THE OTHERS

**We use the others + singular noun to talk about remaining one of the two we mention.  
Other+ plural noun means the remaining ones.  
llowed by a noun**

other + singular noun  
-second of two  
other + plural noun  
- remaining ones

The Others  
Not followed by a noun

This car is nice but the other is better.

You two are here, but where are the other students?

She is a student, the other is a doctor.

The others will attend later.
